Starting today, you can test an API in the trading portal. To do so, please go to <https://verticer.eu/en/betatestapi>. On this page, you will also find all relevant information.

Using the API is not mandatory. You can continue using the trading portal as you do today.

What is an API?

An API (Application Programming Interface) is a digital bridge between two different software systems. It allows systems to exchange data automatically and securely.

Instead of manually transferring data between MyVertiCer and your own systems, the API handles this automatically and in real time.

What do you need to use the API?

To use the API, you will need software developers who can connect the API to your own systems.

It is also important to make updates to your systems when VertiCer implements changes or updates to the API.

Use fictitious test data only

Please do not use personal data or confidential business information while testing the API.

All data entered into the test environment may be visible to other traders participating in the testing phase.

What happens after the testing phase?

The testing phase is expected to continue until autumn 2026. This timeline may change depending on the feedback received by VertiCer. We will keep you informed when the testing phase comes to an end.

After the testing phase, the API will officially go live. At that point, all traders will be able to use the API with their own data.
